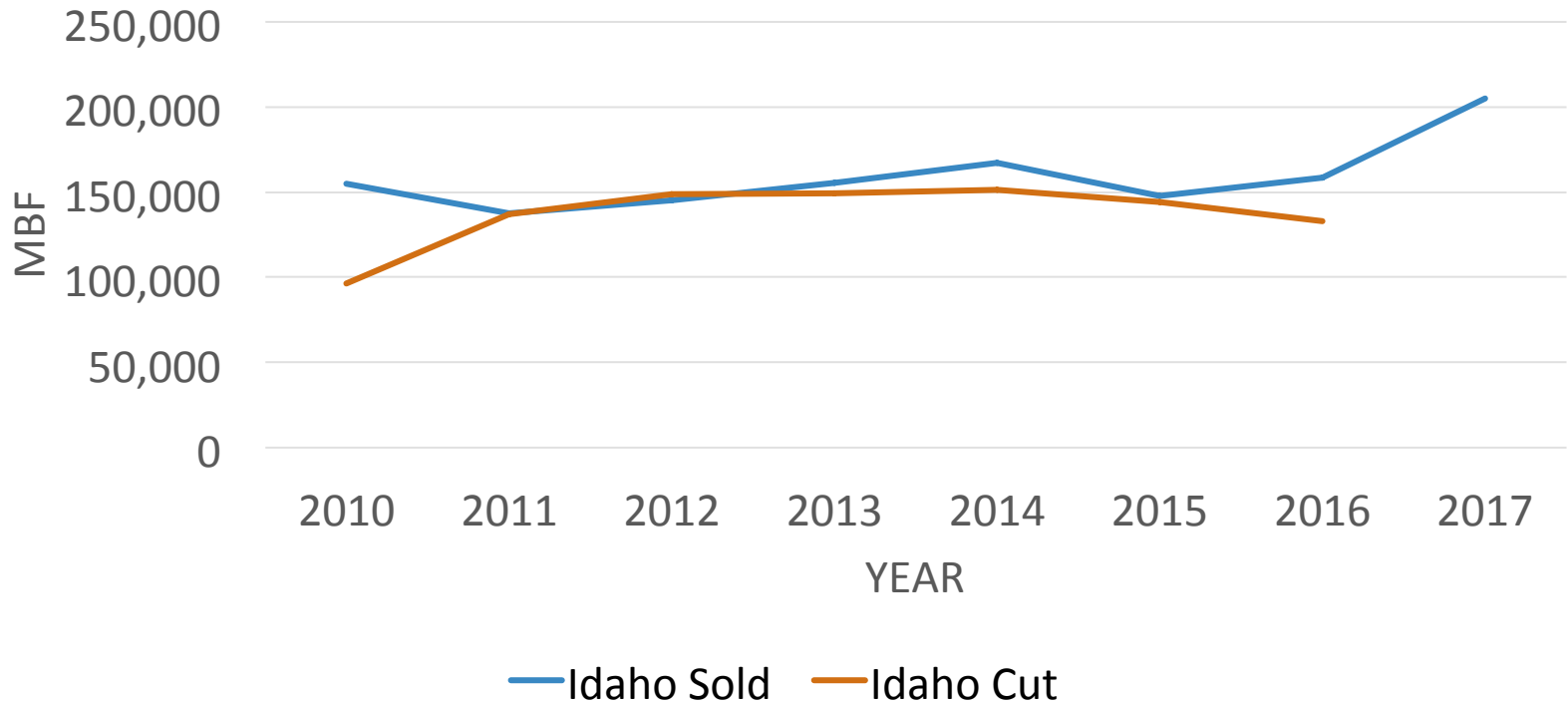

Use of 2014 Farm Bill Insect & Disease Authorities in Idaho

- Over 1.8 million acres of National Forest System lands in Idaho were initially designated as priority landscapes per Idaho Governor Butch Otter's request.
- An additional 2.2+ million acres were recently designated on the Nez Perce-Clearwater, Sawtooth and Idaho Panhandle NFs.
- The Payette requested designation of an additional 550,000+ acres in Idaho and is currently waiting on a response from the Washington Office.

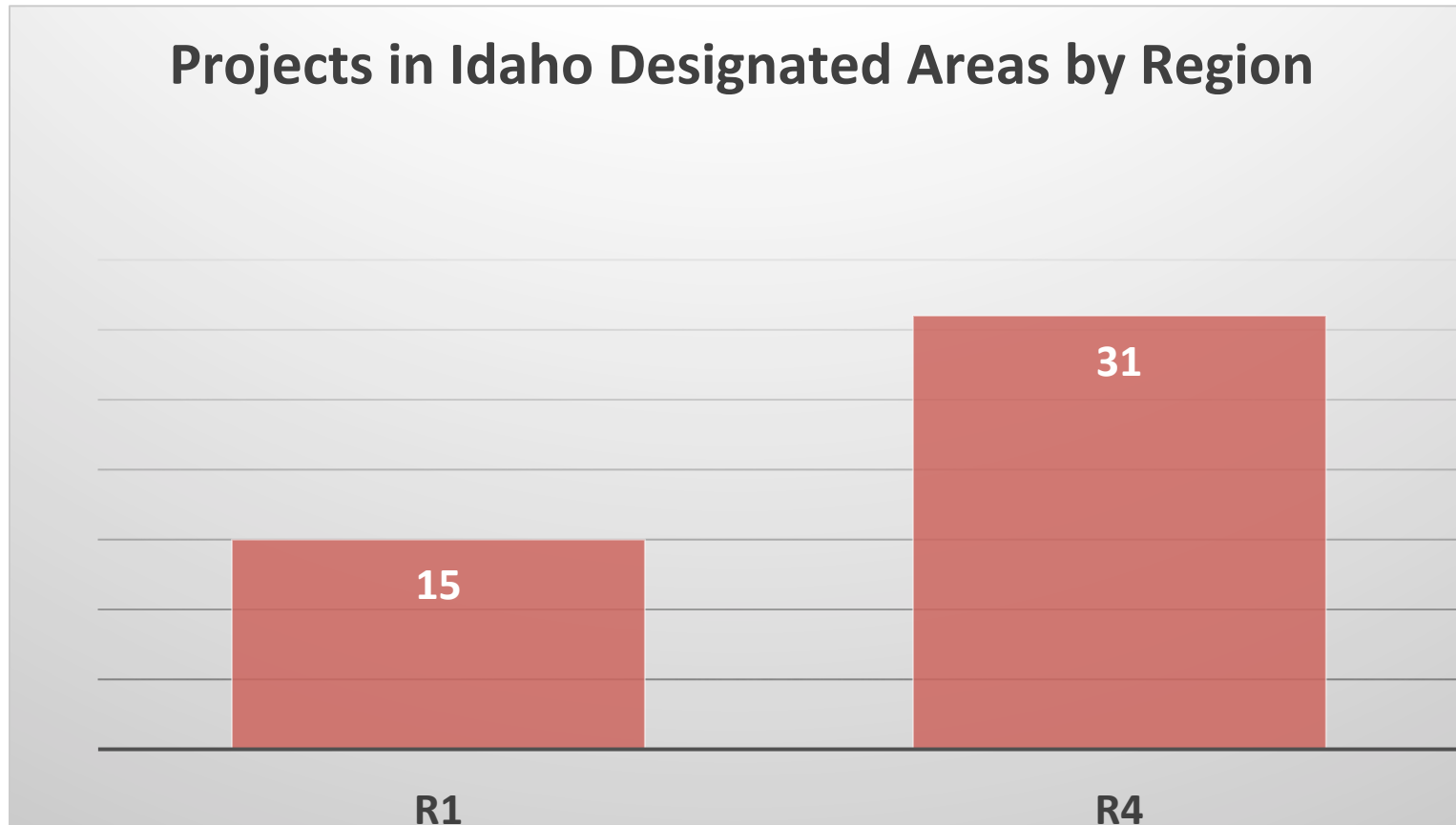

- Ability to leverage state resources to increase capacity to accomplish work on National Forests
