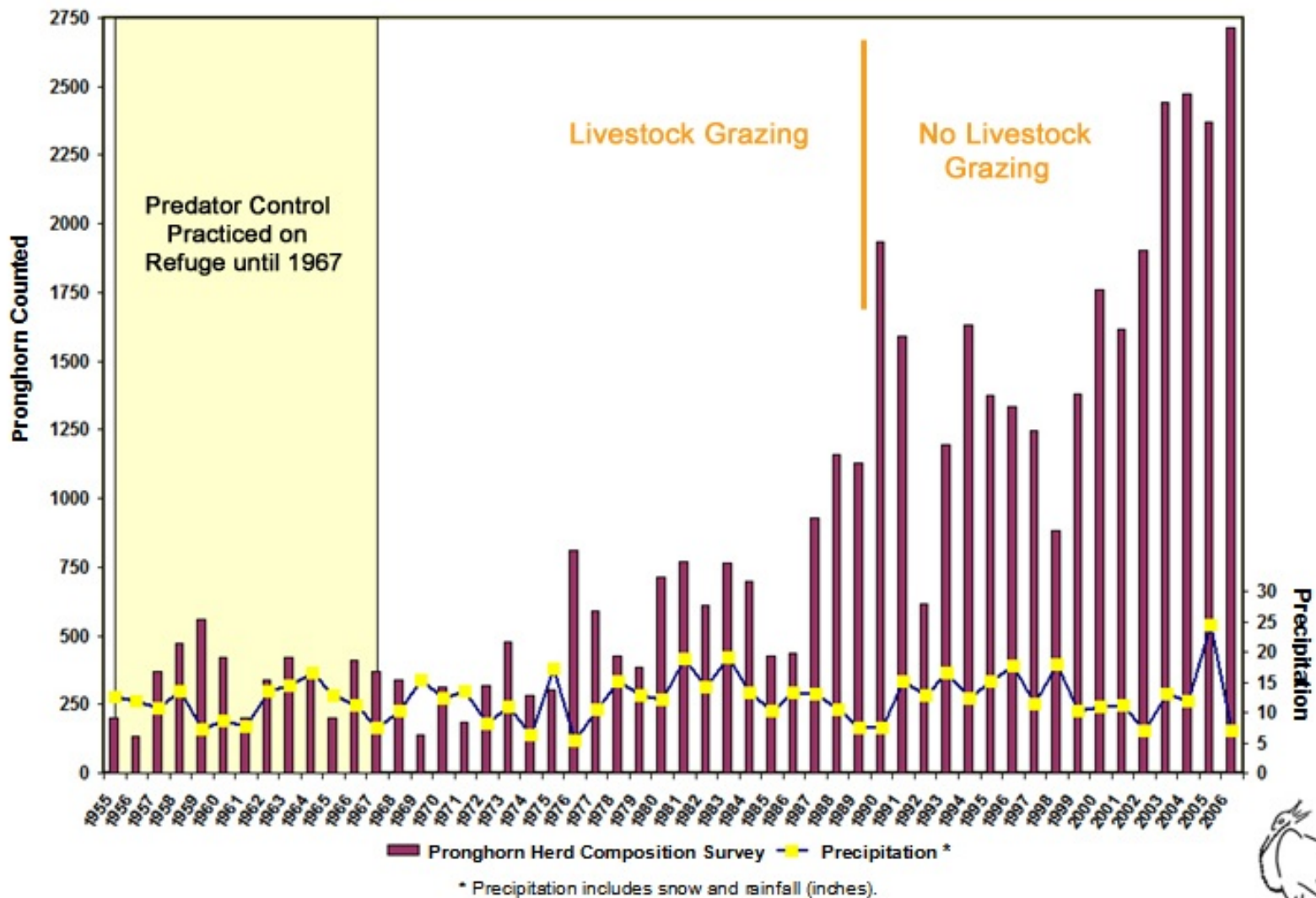

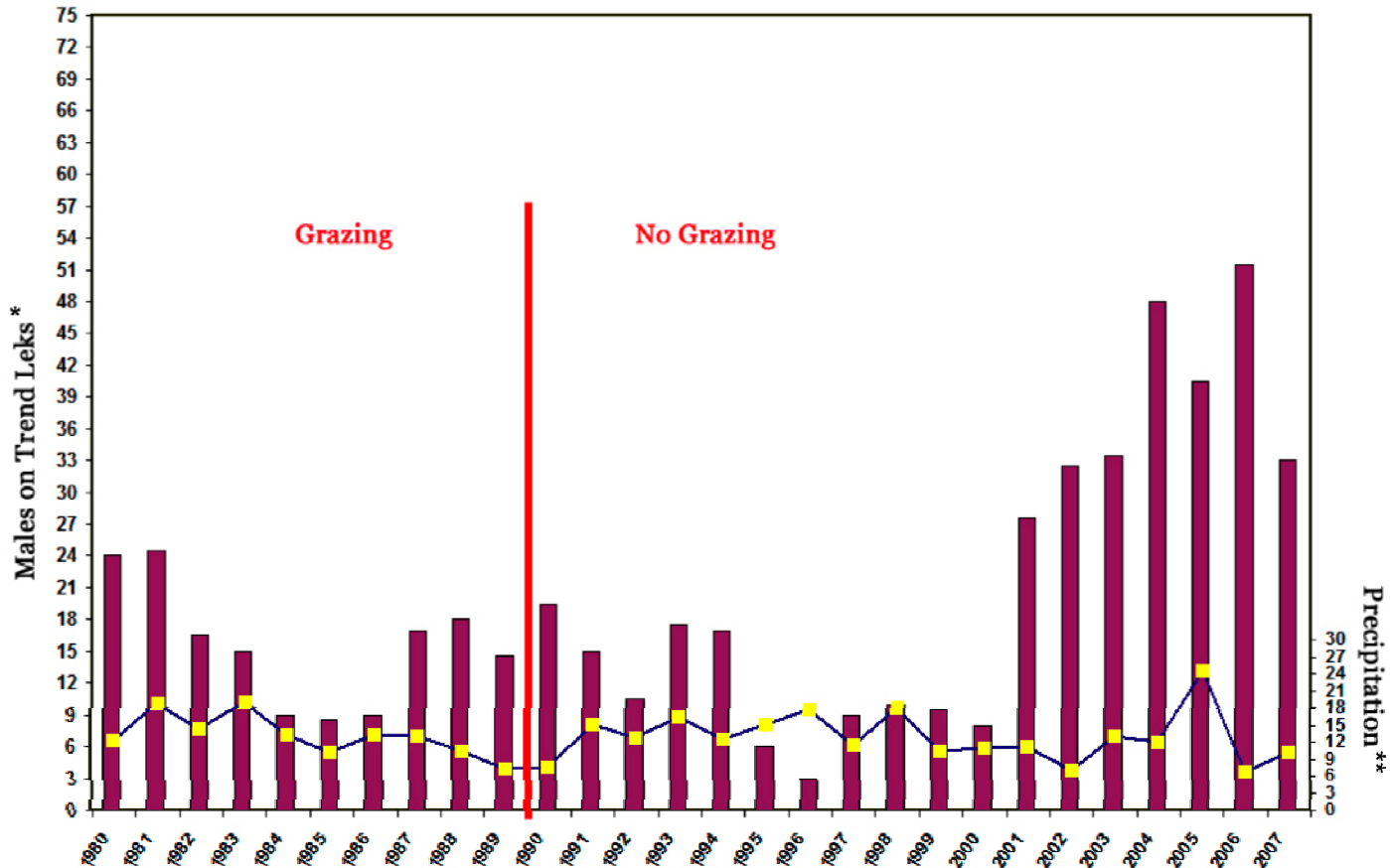
Hart Mountain National Antelope Refuge
